Review report on the condensed interim financial information to the Board of Directors of Bahrain Car Parks Company B.S.C.

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying condensed interim statement of financial position of Bahrain Car Parks Company B.S.C. (“the Company”) as at 31 March 2019, the condensed interim statement of profit or loss, the condensed interim statement of other comprehensive income, the condensed interim statement of changes in shareholders’ equity and the condensed interim statement of cash flows for the three months period then ended, and selected explanatory notes. The Company’s Board of Directors is responsible for the preparation and presentation of this condensed interim financial information in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 - “*Interim Financial Reporting*”. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on this condensed interim financial information based on our review.

Scope of review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standard on Review Engagements 2410 - “*Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity*”. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying condensed interim financial information does not present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Company as at 31 March 2019, and of its financial performance and its cash flows for the three months period then ended in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standard IAS 34 - “*Interim Financial Reporting*”.



1 Organisation and activities

Bahrain Car Parks Company B.S.C. (“the Company”) is a public Bahraini shareholding company registered with the Ministry of Industry and Commerce in the Kingdom of Bahrain and operates under commercial registration number 11455 obtained on 31 October 1981.

The principal activity of the Company includes the operation of car parks, real estate activities with own or leased property and other marketing/promotional activities.

The registered office of the Company is in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

2 Basis of preparation

Basis of presentation

The condensed interim financial information has been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 - “Interim Financial Reporting”. The condensed interim financial information should therefore be read in conjunction with the annual audited financial statements prepared as at, and for the year ended, 31 December 2018, which have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards.

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with IFRS requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise judgment in the process of applying the Company’s accounting policies.

These financial statements have been prepared using the going concern assumption under the historical cost convention, except for the investment classified as financial assets at fair value through other comprehensive income which are recorded at their fair market value at the statement of financial position date.

The financials information has been presented in Bahraini Dinar (BD) which is also the functional currency of the Company.

Improvements/amendments to IFRS/IAS

Improvements/amendments to IFRS/IAS contained numerous amendments to IFRS/IAS that the IASB considers non-urgent but necessary. ‘Improvements to IFRS’ comprise amendments that result in accounting changes to presentation, recognition or measurement purposes, as well as terminology or editorial amendments related to a variety of individual IFRS standards. The amendments are effective for the Company’s future accounting period with earlier adoption.

Standards, amendments and interpretations effective and adopted in 2019

The following new standard, amendment to existing standard or interpretation to published standard is mandatory for the first time for the financial year beginning 1 January 2019 and has been adopted in the preparation of these condensed interim financial information:

IFRS 16 Leases

IFRS 16 supersedes IAS 17 Leases. As a result of adoption of IFRS 16, the Company has recognised right of use assets and lease liabilities for all contracts that are, or contain, a lease. For leases currently classified as operating leases, under previous accounting requirements, the Company did not recognise related assets or liabilities, and instead spread the lease payments on a straight-line basis over the lease term, disclosing in its condensed interim financial information the total commitment.

The Company has adopted and implemented IFRS 16 from 1 January 2019 and therefore the Company has recognised leases on balance sheet as at 1 January 2019. In addition, it also decided to measure right-of-use assets by reference to the measurement of the lease liability on that date.

In accordance with the transition provisions of IFRS 16, instead of recognising an operating expense for its operating lease arrangements, the Company has recognised finance costs on its lease liabilities and amortisation charge on its right-of-use assets. This will increase reported EBITDA by the amount of its operating lease cost.

As a result of the adoption of this standard as of 1 January 2019, BD154,968 was recognised as right-of-use assets and as lease liabilities. The weighted average lessee's incremental borrowing rate applied to the lease liabilities on 1 January 2019 was 6.5%. The following is a reconciliation of total operating lease commitments at 31 December 2018 to the lease liabilities recognised at 1 January 2019:

Early adoption of amendments or standards in 2019

The Company did not early-adopt any new or amended standards in 2019.

3 Significant accounting policies

The accounting policies used in the preparation of the condensed interim financial information are consistent with those used in the annual audited financial statements of the Company prepared as at, and for the year ended 31 December 2018, as described in those annual audited financial statements except for the change arising due to adoption of IFRS 16.

Right-of-use assets

As explained above in Note 2, the Company has implemented IFRS 16 from 1 January 2019 and therefore the Company has recognised a right-of-use assets and lease liability in the condensed interim financial information. In accordance with the transition provisions of IFRS 16, instead of recognising an operating expense for its operating lease arrangements, the Company has recognised finance costs on its lease liabilities and amortisation charge on its right-of-use assets.

The Company recognises a right of use asset and a lease liability at the lease commencement date. The right-of-use of asset is initially measured at cost, which comprises the initial amount of the lease liability adjusted for any lease payments made at or before the commencement date, plus any initial direct costs incurred and an estimate of costs to dismantle and remove the underlying asset or to restore the underlying asset or the site on which it is located, less any lease incentive received.

The right-of-use asset is subsequently amortised using the straight line method from the commencement date to the earlier of the end of the estimated useful life of the right of use asset or the end of the lease term. The estimated useful lives of right of use assets are determined on the same basis as those of equipment and furniture. In addition, the right of use asset is periodically reduced by impairment losses, if any, and adjusted for certain re-measurements of the lease liability.

Amortisation is calculated on a straight line basis over the estimated useful lives of the right of use assets.

3 Significant accounting policies (continued)

Lease liability

The lease is initially measured at the present value of the lease payments that are not paid at the commencement date, discounted using the interest rate implicit in the lease or, if that rate cannot be readily determined, the Company's incremental borrowing rate. Generally, the Company uses its incremental borrowing rate as the discount rate.

Lease payments included in the measurement of the lease liability comprising fixed payments, including in-substance fixed payments.

The lease liability is measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method. It is remeasured when there is a change in future lease payments arising from a change in an index or rate, if there is a change in the Company's estimate of the amount expected to be payable under a residual value guarantee, or if the Company changes its assessment of whether it will exercise a purchase, extension or termination option.

When the lease liability is remeasured in this way, a corresponding adjustment is made to the carrying amount of the right of use asset, or is recorded in profit or loss if the carrying amount of the right of use asset has been reduced to zero.
